EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY the Town Office will no longer accept credit cards in the office or by telephone, as the Town is in the process of updating the computer software and will be accepting online payments in the near future. It will be posted on the outside bulletin board and on the Town website www.middletownva.gov as to when we will be accepting online payments. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience that this may cause, and hope to better serve you with this new service.

As a reminder if water service has been disconnected due to non-payment there will be a fee of \$50.00 to turn off and there will be a fee of \$50.00 to turn on for a total of \$100.00. If it is after hours there will be an additional fee of \$50.00.

Reminder to Middletown residents if you will be having contracted work done at your home such as roofers, tree trimmers, plumbers and building additions just to name a few; the contractor(s) needs to obtain a business license from the Town of Middletown.

If the Town Office receives three or more returned checks from an individual, all further transactions will be by money order or cash ONLY. The return check fee has increased from \$30.00 to \$45.00.

The Town Office will **not** accept large amounts of unrolled change. If you must use change it must be rolled in coin wrappers.

The annual Spring Clean Up will be held on Monday April 21, 2014. Please have items out FIRST THING Monday morning. Collected items will be landfill acceptable items; including furniture. The following items **WILL NOT** be accepted: appliances; TV's; computers; computer monitors; microwave ovens; paint; hazardous

waste; tires or lawn equipment with gasoline powered engines. Please keep yard waste separate from other items.

Yard waste collection will resume on Monday April 7, 2014 and will be collected every Monday thereafter. Yard waste should consist of branches or twigs **not larger** than four (4) feet in length and **not larger** than two (2) inches in diameter and tied in bundles (no wire or plastic string). Yard waste should be placed in biodegradable or paper yard waste bags only **NO PLASTIC BAGS.**
